Homework Policy

Rationale:

- Homework is an opportunity for parents or carers to participate in their child's education. Homework benefits students by complementing and reinforcing classroom learning, fostering good, lifelong study habits and providing an opportunity for students to be responsible for their own learning.

Aims:

- To support and extend classroom learning.
- To develop positive study habits.
- To develop a responsibility for personal learning.

Implementation:

- The school's homework policy is outlined to parents at the start of each year at Grade Information Evenings.
- We acknowledge that parents expect their children to have homework.
- Just as a parent guides their child on the journey to walking and talking, tying shoe laces and telling the time, it is expected that parents will assist their child in achieving these minimum expectations. All students from K – Yr 6 will have the following minimum expectation:

K-1 Number ID and counting activities with a 100's chart, Sight Words and Reading Log.

2-4 Reading Log and Multiplication Facts

5-6 Multiplication Facts, Reading Log, and homework tab on Google Classroom that will allow development of time management, study habits, concentration and self discipline.

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
