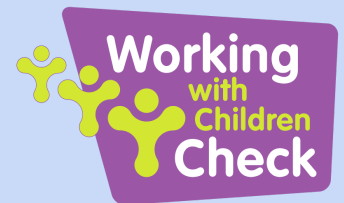

YEAR 1 - Game on

In 2016 Mrs Gippel applied for Sporting Schools funding with great success. Therefore Year 1 students will be lucky enough to receive a fully paid for program run by NSW Rugby Union Development Officers in Term 1, 2017.

ST EDWARD'S NETBALL NEWS

A big thank you to the people who helped out with St Edward's Netball Clubs gate duty over the Country Music Festival, Clare and Michael Dubois, John Baird, Katrina Davis, Nikki Bridge, Belinda Lane, Bec Evans, Tania Young, Tarrah Bower and Cassandra Mitchell.

The 2017 winter competition will be played at the Tamworth Sports Dome each Saturday beginning Saturday 29th April, 2017. Here is some information about how Netball runs.

Net, Set, Go! (NSG) is three tiered. NSG starts at 12pm and players will receive a Net,Set,Go pack which usually arrives before the end of the netball season.

NSG 5-7 Yrs. Activity/Skills. This is a play-based movement/skills program where the emphasis is on the acquisition of basic movement skills, in a fun environment of games and activities. Kindergarten and Year 1 can register for this tier. These children are *not* placed in a team and do not play 'real' netball (Kindergarten & Year 1 children can choose between this tier or the next one).

NSG 8-10 Yrs. Skills/Competition. Children are in teams. They learn to play netball using the modified rules, lower netball ring etc. This is a non-competitive competition with guidance and coaching. This tier is for Kindergarten, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 students. *Please note that if you nominate your Kindergarten or Year 1 child to play in this tier, they may end up playing with and/or against children older than them.*

NSG 10 Yrs. Competition. This is a competitive competition for children who are in Year 4. Children who play in this tier do not play finals netball, but they do have a competition ladder.

Juniors (11-17 Yrs.) play at 1pm. They play by the 'normal' netball rules with the correct netball ring height. This is a competitive competition with finals netball being played and trophies awarded. This is for Year 5 and Year 6 students. If your child is turning 10, but is in Year 5, please register/pay for this level.

Uniform: Players wear the St Edward's netball uniform, which can be purchased during the registration process or from the Primary School canteen for a cost of \$55.00. St Ed's netball visors are also available at a cost of \$12.00 each

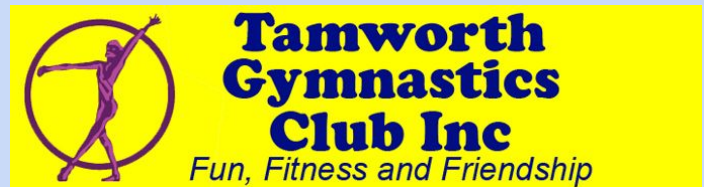

The 2017 Touch Football Semester 1 Competition commences on Monday 20th February, 2017 until Monday 29th May, 2017. The competition consists of three divisions;

Division 1 – Kindergarten – Year 2

This competition is played on Monday afternoons at 4:30pm. The cost is \$40 per child. The teams are mixed with no less than 2 girls on the field at one time, with a total of 6 players on the field at a time. Each team must have a coach who is present on the field with the team at all times. This division will be run as a social competition with the main aim to teach the children to play Touch and to have fun.

Division 2 – Year 3 & 4

This competition is played on Monday afternoons at 4:30pm. The cost is \$40 per child. Teams are to be all girls and all boys, with 6 players on the field at a time. These sides can also have their coach on the field.

Division 3 – Year 5 & 6

This competition is played on Monday afternoons at 5:20pm. The cost is \$40 per child. Teams are to be all girls and all boys, with 6 players on the field at a time. Coaches are not permitted on the field.

OZTAG

COMPETITION: Games will commence on **Wednesday 15th February (U/6 (MiNiTaG)*, 8, 10 & 12 yrs)**. The competition includes 1 Trial Game (no points awarded), followed by 6 Round Games in Term 1 and breaks over Winter. Competition resumes in the 2nd week of Term 4 (18th October) with 5 more rounds followed by Semi-Finals and Grand Finals on **Wednesday 29th November** for Primary Schools and **Thursday 30th November** for High Schools. * U/6's will have 2 separate competitions in Term 1 & Term 4.

DELEGATE: A reminder that ALL teams must have a **team delegate** and this is to be included on the team sheet. A team delegates role is simply to be a point of contact, they may also be the coach but they must be willing to liaise with the team. See 'Wet Weather' for importance of mobile no.

OZTAG ONLINE REGISTRATION – Australian Oztag Sports Association (AOSA) requires ALL players EVERY SEASON to manage their OASA membership online. At the beginning of each competition, players will need to login and activate their AOSA membership. Players will not be considered a “registered” player until their membership has been activated. **This is done automatically if you pay online.** Failure to activate will affect representative eligibility and insurance cover. **COST** is \$90 for U/8's – U/16's (Term 1 & 4), MiNiTaG is \$45 per term.

DIVISIONS: The following Divisions are MIXED: Mini Tag: 6 yrs & Under; 8 yrs & Under. Mixed teams (except Mini) MUST PLAY no more than 4 boys on the field at any time. The following Divisions are single sex: 10 yrs & Under; 12 yrs & Under.

The MINI TAG (6Yrs & Under) Division is Non-Competitive and will operate 2 different competitions in Term 1 and Term 4. MiNiTaG players will register at the start of each of these terms. All players will receive a Playing Shirt after signing up.

TEAMS: Matching playing shirts are not compulsory but it is a good idea to coordinate your team with an agreed colour T-shirt to play in. Most school teams play in their sports shirts. If you would like to organise team shirts 'Thread Effects' will look after you. All teams must have a minimum of 10 players. OZTAG SHORTS ARE COMPULSORY and can be purchased from the admin desk.

CANCELLED GAMES: If games are to be cancelled due to inclement weather, schools will be notified in the afternoon, FM 92.9 will make announcements and a message will be left on my phone, 0421 019 462. The website and Tamworth Junior Oztag Facebook and Instagram pages will have updates.
